



INSERT FRAMES

Replacement aluminium inserts is a popular method of updating an existing window or door without having to fully replace it. It is often cheaper to install an insert into an existing frame than to replace the whole frame entirely, and creates less waste during the renovation as the original frame is reused.

Insert frames require the existing frame to be structurally sound to support the weight of the new insert, meaning that if your old windows have been leaking these may not be an option.

FULL REPLACEMENT

Replacement linear frames are a more traditional approach to installing aluminium joinery, replacement linear frames are a great option for homes with leaky or damaged windows. When replacing leaky windows, a standard linear frame will completely remove the old, damaged frame, ensuring a better seal against wind and moisture.

As full replacements with linear require the removal of the old frames, the install process can be more disruptive and is usually more expensive.
